HOW DO VETERANS BENEFIT FROM EQUINEASSISTED SERVICES?

Heroes On Horseback is a program provided by Majestic Hills Ranch, a 501(c)3 non-profit foundation. This program offers equine-assisted services, pro-bono, to injured armed forces personnel, active duty and veterans in rehabilitation who have sustained a wide variety of physical injuries and/or psychological trauma including, but not limited to, PTSD.

Our Goal is to engage injured veterans and active military personnel in a variety of equine-assisted activities designed to achieve measurable physical, behavioral, cognitive, psychological and communicative goals.

We believe that equine assisted services, as described by PATH, Intl. (Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship, Intl.) contributes significantly to the lives of people with physical, emotional, and mental impairment.

We know that horses heal. The gentle and rhythmic motion of a horse's walking gait increases the riders muscle strength while improving coordination, balance, and flexibility. The special relationship formed with a horse can lead to increased self-confidence, enhanced self-esteem, improved decision-making skills, personal insight, a strong sense of achievement, increased recognition of boundary issues, and social skills that include increased patience.



The horse and human bond and its healing power has been known since antiquity. The horse's non-judgmental acceptance and tolerance helps veterans with disabilities to be motivated to learn, grow, and realize their fullest potential.

With the help of specially chosen and trained horses, our knowledgeable instructors, and trained volunteers, our veterans with disabilities and injured active duty personnel are taught horseback riding and horsemanship skills appropriate to their level of ability. Physical, occupational, recreational therapists, speech language pathologists, and primary caregivers are invited to work with our instructors to develop individualized riding plans with mental and physical goals.

Equine-Assisted Services can provide significant benefits to individuals challenged with:

- Amputation
- Behavior Disability
- Traumatic Brain Injury
- Emotional Disability
- Hearing Impairment
- Post Traumatic
- Visual Impairment
- Stress Disorder
- Substance
 Dependence
- ...to name a few.

For individuals with physical disabilities: The rhythmic and rocking walking gait of the horse transfers a gentle three-dimensional movement to the rider that relaxes muscles, and improves muscle tone, flexibility, balance, and their spatial awareness. With greater freedom of movement comes an increase in selfesteem, confidence, personal mobility, and independence.

For individuals with cognitive disabilities: Horseback riding offers an opportunity to improve their concentration, attention span, memory, and language / communication skills.

For individuals with behavioral and emotional challenges: The positive horse-human interaction can result in a greater understanding of teamwork, responsibility, and communication in relationships. As the bond develops, so does the person's ability and willingness to regain knowledge and skills necessary in their everyday lives.
